RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FINANCIAL AND ECONOMIC ANALYSIS RELATING TO THE TOLEDO-COLUMBUS CORRIDOR STUDY FOR PASSENGER RAIL

Whereas, on December 6, 2021, Bowling Green City Council passed Resolution 3809 in support of the development of a passenger rail line from Toledo to Columbus with a stop in Bowling Green;

Whereas, the City of Toledo and the Toledo Metropolitan Council of Governments (TMACOG) are funding a concept analysis for the Toledo-Columbus corridor to consider potential rail routes between the two cities; and

Whereas, the addition of a financial, cost benefit, and economic analysis to is a necessary companion study to the concept analysis as it would be needed for Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) and United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) review related to potential future funding requests; and

Whereas, the analysis will assess the operating and capital costs for the project and develop an assessment of the operating ratio and the financial return of the project including cash flow projections for the twenty-five-year life of the project; and

Whereas, upon completion, the report will be integrated with the Toledo City Council/TMACOG concept analysis to form a joint feasibility report.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN

SECTION 1: The Council of the City of Bowling Green authorizes participation in the financial and economic analysis relating to the Toledo-Columbus corridor study for passenger rail, thereby committing \$5,000 to the project.

SECTION 2: This resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
