APPROVING MODIFICATIONS TO  
RIDER E RENEWABLE PARALLEL GENERATION

WHEREAS, the City owns and operates an electric distribution system for the benefit of its customers; and


WHEREAS, Rider E was approved on October 12, 2020 in order to recover the City's cost to provide electric service to customers with Interconnection Applications and to ensure that other electric customers are not subsidizing customers with renewable generation; and


WHEREAS, Rider E states that the avoided cost rate will be determined annually and may be adjusted at any time to the credited purchase rate for Customer's excess generation; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, a majority of the Bowling Green Board of Public Utilities approve the modifications to Rider E Renewable Parallel Generation in the Electric Rate Schedule, adjusting the Purchase Rate to \$0.0750/kWh, as attached.
