RESOLUTION HONORING KAY SCHERREIK, CLERK OF COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO

WHEREAS, Kay D. Scherreik skillfully and successfully served as the Clerk of Council for the City of Bowling Green from October 24, 1989 until May 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, during her over thirty years of service, Kay contributed significantly to the professional and efficient operation of the Bowling Green City Council and improved the City of Bowling Green organization through her quality work; and

WHEREAS, in her time as Clerk, the City Council passed over 5,000 pieces of legislation and held hundreds of Council meetings; and

WHEREAS, Kay's approachable personality, vast knowledge, and noteworthy experience made her a trusted and reliable resource for the many Council Members with whom she worked over the course of three plus decades and, in her approach to Council meetings and her work for the City, Kay earned the respect of those Members; and

WHEREAS, in her time at the City of Bowling Green, Kay was asked to take on additional responsibilities within the organization and she approached these duties with a high level of skill which impacted city operations in many positive ways; and

WHEREAS, Kay garnered respect from her colleagues at the City of Bowling Green—including the Mayors, Municipal Administrators, and Department Heads with whom she worked closely—and was a trustworthy and caring colleague to her fellow city staff members; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to publicly recognize and honor Kay D. Scherreik for her significant and lasting contributions to the City of Bowling Green.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND TO ACCOUNT FOR THE ONEOHIO OPIOID SETTLEMENTS

WHEREAS, at its meeting on August 10, 2021, Council adopted Ordinance No. 3802 accepting the terms of the OneOhio subdivision settlement pursuant to the OneOhio memorandum of understanding (MOU) consistent with the terms of the July 21, 2021 National Opioid Settlement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Auditor of State Bulletin 2022-003 issued on March 10, 2022, and Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.09(F) indicates that the City's share of the OneOhio Funds shall be placed in a separate special revenue fund and used only for the approved purposes as required by the OneOhio MOU.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to establish a new special revenue fund to account for the receipts and expenditures of moneys received pursuant to the OneOhio Opioid Settlement Plan.

SECTION 2: That all funds distributed to the City of Bowling Green, pursuant to the OneOhio subdivision settlement shall be placed in such special revenue fund be used only for the approved purposes as required by the OneOhio MOU.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

ORDINANCE ACCEPTING EASEMENT FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY AND UTILITY PURPOSES FROM PHOENIX TECHNOLOGIES INTERNATIONAL, LLC, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, COUNTY OF WOOD, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the grant of easement from Phoenix Technologies International, LLC for additional right-of-way on Fairview Avenue is hereby accepted in substantial accordance with the exhibit attached hereto and made a part hereof. Said property is hereby dedicated for right-of-way and all municipal purposes by this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect as an emergency measure. The reason for the emergency is the prompt effectiveness of this measure is necessary in order to facilitate the expansion of Fairview Avenue which will be done in concert with the expansion of the Phoenix Technologies International, LLC business located at the sites generally known as 1118 Fairview Avenue and 1098 Fairview Avenue in Bowling Green, to facilitate said improvements being substantially completed during the 2022 construction season.
